Job Summary

Clean Harbors is currently looking for a Journeyman Plumber/Gasfitter to assist with our K+S Potash Legacy Project in Bethune, SK. The successful candidate will be responsible for performing a variety of tasks each day and must be able to perform a full range of plumbing/gas fitting assignments such as, read and follow blue prints, material takeoff, and installation of equipment and fixtures, inspect and test plumbing/gas systems, diagnose and repair malfunctioning systems, knowledge of the Alberta/Canadian Building Code, instruct and mentor lower level employees.

Key Responsibilities

- Ensure health and safety is the number one goal by following policies, processes and acting in a safe manner at all times.
- Assemble pipe sections, tubing, or fittings, using couplings, clamps, screws, bolts, cement, plastic solvent, caulking, or soldering, brazing, or welding equipment
- Install pipe assemblies, fittings, valves, appliances such as dishwashers, water heaters, ranges, stove tops, etc. or fixtures such as sinks or toilets, using hand or power tools
- Cut openings in structures to accommodate pipes or pipe fittings, using hand or power tools
- Review blueprints, building codes, or specifications to determine work details or procedures
- Study building plans and inspect structures to assess material and equipment needs, to establish the sequence of pipe installations, and to plan installation around obstructions such as electrical wiring
- Locate and mark the position of pipe installations, connections, passage holes, or fixtures in structures, using measuring instruments such as rulers or levels
- Oversee and mentor all employees and apprentices engaged in pipe cutting, preassembly, or installation of plumbing systems or components
- Supervise, train and mentor site labourers in addition to registered apprentices as required
