The **six (6) Summer Students/Seasonal Workers** will support the Paskwa Garden team and will participate in the following tasks:

- Field work to assist in places on the landscape.
- Help create the garden space from seeding to harvest.
- Daily maintenance tasks; watering, weeding etc.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Knowledge of, or interest in learning more on gardening
- Must have strong organizational skills, be hardworking, a team player, and be an excellent communicator.
- Eager and willing to learn team dynamics and have the ability to work independently or with minimal supervision.
- Ability to maintain a healthy working relationship with staff, Nation representatives/members
- Effective attention to detail, problem-identification and problem-resolution skills.
- Ability to prioritize tasks and complete them in a timely and effective manner.
- Physically fit for daily outdoor work.
- Capable of lifting and carrying equipment and/or boxes of up to 50 lbs.
- Willing to drive a tractor and/or utility vehicle on site
- Must be willing to take direction from the Supervisor
